## **2025 WHEAT TOURS & AG ECON MEETINGS**



Many staff members of Farm Credit of Western Kansas attended area wheat plot tours put on by the KSU Extension Office and agricultural economics meetings put on by KFMA the past few months. Some of the area wheat tours were hindered (THANKFULLY) by some rain showers. Below are some figures presented at the KFMA meetings that pertain to the ninecounty area serviced by the Association. The data below is based on 48 farms.

Cheyenne/Sherman/Wallace – 2024 Average Net Farm Income totaled \$135,193 Rawlins/Thomas/Logan – 2024 Average Net Farm Income totaled \$157,216 Decatur/Sheridan/Gove – 2024 Average Net Farm Income totaled \$82,702

(TOTAL AVERAGE = \$125,037)

The average net farm income for the Association's nine county territory of \$125,037 was essentially half of what the historic average was from 2020-2023. It might be surprising it's as high as it is given the year, but it highlights what the cattle enterprises have been able to do, the decent 2024 wheat yields, and the amount of government aid received in the form of crop insurance on fall crops and the Emergency Commodity Assistance Program (ECAP) payments. Per KFMA, nearly 90% of the average net farm income was attributable to government assistance in 2024.

#### Error Resolution Notice for Electronic Funds Transfer Borrowers

In case of errors or questions about your Electronic Transfers, call us at 785-462-6714, write us at PO Box 667 Colby KS 67701, or email us at 931onlinebanking@fcwk.com as soon as possible, if you think your statement or receipt is wrong or if you need more information about a transfer listed on the statement or receipt. We must hear from you no later than 60 days after we sent the FIRST statement in which the problem or error arose.

(1) Tell us your name and account number (if any).

(2) Describe the error or the transfer you are unsure about and explain as clearly as you can why you believe it is an error or why you need more information.

(3) Tell us the dollar amount of the suspected error.

If you tell us orally, we may require that you send us your complaint or question in writing within 10 business days.

We will determine whether an error occurred within 10 business days after we hear from you and will correct any error promptly. If we need more time, however, we may take up to 45 days to investigate your complaint or question. If we decide to do this, we will credit your account within 10 business days for the amount you think is in error, so that you will have the use of the money during the time it takes us to complete our investigation. If we ask you to put your complaint or question in writing and we do not receive it within 10 business days, we may not credit your account.

For errors involving new accounts, point-of-sale, or foreign-initiated transactions, we may take up to 90 days to investigate your complaint or question. For new accounts, we may take up to 20 business days to credit your account for the amount you think is in error.

We will tell you the results within three business days after completing our investigation. If we decide that there was no error, we will send you a written explanation. You may ask for copies of the documents that we used in our investigation.
